From 1987 to 1991, Richelsen was managing director of 3M France, one of 3M's biggest international companies. He has announced he will retire from 3M August 1, 2000.

The company is organized into two business segments; the Glass Technologies businesses are leaders primarily in architectural glass and high-end glass coatings for electronics, while the Glass Services businesses are leaders in replacement auto glass and building glass services. Apogee's annual sales are nearly \$1 billion.
